people who needed it.





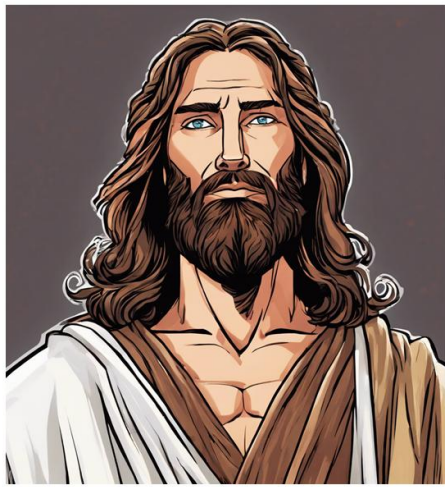
